MAY 2024 — OVERVIEW FOR THE MONTH

The Easter season ends on Pentecost, May 20, which is represented by the liturgical color white — the color of light, a symbol of joy, purity, and innocence (absolute or restored). The remainder of the month (beginning the Monday after Pentecost) is in Ordinary Time which is represented by the liturgical color green. This symbol of hope is the color of the sprouting seed and arouses in the faithful the hope of reaping the eternal harvest of heaven, especially the hope of a glorious resurrection.

BABY BOTTLE CAMPAIGN

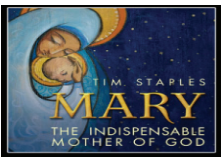

Bl. Pier Giorgio Frassati is commonly invoked as patron of Catholic young adults. Known as "The Man of the Beatitudes", Pier Giorgio died at age twenty-four in 1925; an avid outdoorsman and mountaineer, he achieved great heights of personal holiness and service in his short life.

A carabiner is a self-locking metal clasp, often used in climbing. Strong and durable, they connect and anchor ropes. Like mountain climbing, the Christian life requires strength and perseverance, and our faith community helps connect and anchor us in the truth of our Faith. Animated by the spirit of Bl.
