WHAT IS ADORATION?

When Catholics say they are “going to Adoration,” they are typically referring to Eucharistic Adoration. Which, in the most basic terms, is the worship of the Eucharist outside of the Mass. The Eucharistic Host is displayed in a monstrance on the altar so that all can see and pray in the presence of Christ.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us that, “Adoration is the first attitude of man acknowledging that he is a creature before his Creator. It exalts the greatness of the Lord who made us and the almighty power of the Savior who sets us free from evil. Adoration is homage of the spirit to the “King of Glory, “respectful silence in the presence of the “ever greater” God. Adoration of the thrice holy and sovereign God of love blends with humility and gives assurance to our supplications.” (CCC 2628)

We can show our adoration to God in many ways, but in Eucharistic Adoration, we spend time adoring the true presence of Christ in the Eucharist.

***FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD-
WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE CONSECRATED***

The World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life is February 2nd, which is also the Feast of the Lord. Celebration of this day of prayer is Feb. 1-2, to allow parishes to highlight the gift of religious life and pray for those discerning a religious vocation.

St. John Paul II established the World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life in 1997 to be celebrated in conjunction with the feast of the Presentation of the Lord, also known as Candlemas Day, which highlights the fact that Christ is the light of the world through the symbolic lighting of candles. “Similarly, consecrated men and women are called to spread the light and love of Jesus Christ through their unique witness of selfless service, such as caring for the poor, the contemplative work of prayer, or through their professional careers.”

BLESSED CARLOS ACUTIS WILL BE CANONIZED

on April 27, 2025, in Rome. **Blessed Pier Giorgio Michelangelo Frassati** will be canonized on August 3, 2025, in Rome. Both events will be part of the Jubilee Year of Hope celebrations. The Jubilee for Teenagers in Rome takes place April 25-27 and the Jubilee for Youth (young adults aged 18-35) takes place July 28-August 3. The Diocese of Hamilton is not sponsoring pilgrimages to Rome for these events; however, parishes may wish to mark the canonization of these two remarkable young men in their parishes. Blessed Carlos will be the first “millennial saint”!
