food vouchers and/or store vouchers 88 times to families in need. 124 adults and 94 children were served during the past year. Without your generosity this would not have been possible. May God bless you.

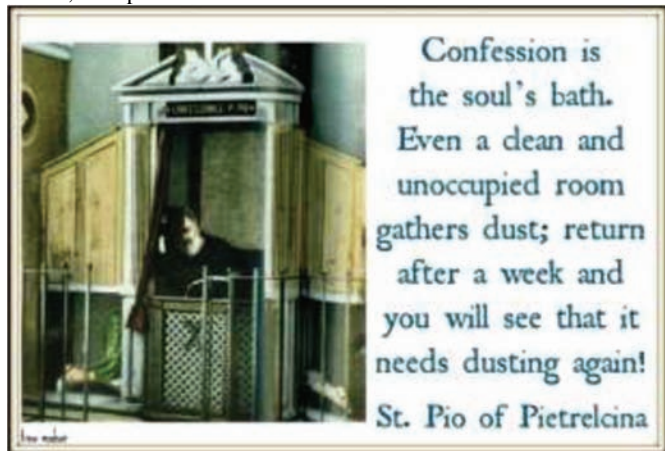
ADORERS NEEDED AS ADORATION 'ANCHORS' AND 'SUBS'

LENTE MISSION RETREAT

Guelph and Wellington Catholic Parishes presents a Lenten Mission Retreat – "The wisdom of the desert, Flee, be silent, pray without ceasing." **Starting Monday March 27 to Wednesday March 29th.** Each night will begin with holy hour from 6pm to 7pm followed by a Spiritual talk by Father Michael King. Tuesday March 28 with have a Penance Celebration following the talk (multiple Priests will be available) and Wednesday March 29 will have Mass at 7pm with Extended Homily. This mission will take place at St Joseph Catholic Parish, Guelph. All are welcome to attend.



SACRAMENT OF PENANCE

So that this Lenten period may be a time of conversion and repentance, let us try to prepare ourselves for the Sacrament of Penance by analyzing our approach. Here is a reminder of the five conditions for a good confession.

EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE

-examine the state of my soul from my last confession

SORROW FOR HAVING OFFENDED GOD

-sorry for the sins I committed

A RESOLUTION OF SIN NO MORE

-decide to do everything in my power to prevent these same sins from happening

CONFESSION OF OUR SINS

-confess ALL my sins to the priest

REPARATION TO GOD & NEIGHBOUR

-do the penance given by the priest

PENITENTIAL DISCIPLINE

LAW OF THE GOSPEL: The Church wants emphasis to be given to the evangelical law that a follower of Christ must do penance. While the heart of penance is hatred for sin as an offence against God

(*CSL, no. 109b*), external forms of penance are required to deepen and encourage the internal virtue.

FRIDAYS are days of abstinence from meat, but Catholic can substitute special acts of charity or piety on this day.

LENT has a penitential character. During Lent, penance is an important requirement of Christian life. Fulfilment of this duty involves prayer, works of piety and charity, and self-denial by fulfilling one's obligations more faithfully and especially by observing the prescribed fast and abstinence.

ASH WEDNESDAY and GOOD FRIDAY in the Roman Rite, including Canada, are days of fasting and of abstinence from meat.

(THE LAW OF "ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT" BINDS THOSE WHO ARE 14 UNTIL DEATH; THE LAW OF "FASTING" BINDS THOSE FROM 18 TO 59 YEARS OF AGE).

THE PASCAL FAST is observed on Good Friday and, where possible, continued through Holy Saturday. (*Christians fasting obtains its full meaning when we deprive ourselves of food in order to be more open to prayer, to share more in the suffering of those who are starving and to save money to give to the poor. Fasting is a penitential discipline intended to open our hearts to God and others, a means of purification and spiritual liberation, a witness of the depth of our faith.*)

PRIVILEGED FORMS OF PENANCE are recommended, especially during Lent. These forms are privileged because they are based on the teaching of the Gospels (fasting, prayer, works of mercy) or because of their traditional value among the people of God (abstinence from meat).

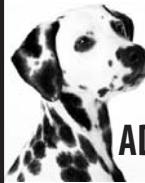
