

EIGHT WORLD DAY OF THE POOR - NOVEMBER 17, 2024



In his 2016 apostolic letter *Misericordia et misera*, issued at the conclusion of the extraordinary jubilee of mercy, Pope Francis

announced the institution of the World Day of the Poor:

During the "Jubilee for Socially Excluded People," as the Holy Doors of Mercy were being closed in all the cathedrals and shrines of the world, I had the idea that, as yet another tangible sign of this Extraordinary Holy Year, the entire Church might celebrate, on the Thirty-Third Sunday of Ordinary Time, the World Day of the Poor.

This would be the worthiest way to prepare for the celebration of the Solemnity of our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, who identified with the little ones and the poor and who will judge us on our works of mercy (cf. Mt 25:31-46). It would be a day to help communities and each of the baptized to reflect on how poverty is at the very heart of the Gospel and that, as long as Lazarus lies at the door of our homes (cf. Lk 16:19-21), there can be no justice or social peace. This Day will also represent a genuine form of new evangelization (cf. Mt 11:5) which can renew the face of the Church as she perseveres in her perennial activity of pastoral conversion and witness to mercy.

PRESENTATION OF MARY - NOVEMBER 21, 2024

"Sacred Scripture contains no text concerning the event commemorated in today's liturgy. For something of a historical background one may consult the apocryphal works, particularly the Protoevangel of St. James (ch. 4:1ff). After an angel revealed her pregnancy, Anna is said to have vowed to her future child Mary to the Lord. Soon after birth the infant was brought to the sacred precincts at which only the best of Israel's daughters was admitted. At the age of three she was transferred to the temple proper (7:2). According to legend, here she was reared like a dove and received her nourishment from the hand of an angel (8:1).

"In the East, where the feast, celebrated since the eighth century, is kept as a public holiday, it bears the name, 'The Entrance of the Mother of God into the Temple'. It was introduced at Rome by a Cypriotic legate to the papal court of Avignon in 1371. In 1472, Sixtus IV extended its observance to the whole Church. Abolished by Pius V, it was reintroduced some years later (1585)."

ADVENT SERVICE OF LESSONS AND CAROLS SUNDAY, DECEMBER 1 AT 4:00PM

The weeks before Christmas are usually a hurried time of shopping, preparations, and card writing. For Christians, however, these weeks should be marked by prayerful preparation for the Feast of Our Lord's Nativity. You are welcome to begin Advent this year with an Advent Service of Lessons and Carols, at the **Basilica of Our Lady Immaculate in Guelph**. This service will be a reflection on the Season of Advent through Scripture and Music, following a format that has been used for almost a century at St. John's College, Cambridge. This year's **service will begin at 4:00pm** on the First Sunday of Advent, **December 1, 2024**. Please come and bring a friend!

NOVENA FOR THE SOLEMNITY OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION

Once again, this year a Novena (nine days) of Masses leading to the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception will be held at the **Basilica** of Our Lady Immaculate in Guelph. Novena Masses will be held at 7:30 each morning from November 30 to December 8, and will include the Novena Prayers, and a reflection on Our Lady in the life of Christ, and the life of the Church. On the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, December 9 this year, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for Adoration at the Basilica following Morning Prayer at 8:30am, until Vespers and Benediction at 6:15pm. The Solemn Mass of the Immaculate Conception will be celebrated at 7:00pm. As the Diocese's Shrine of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Plenary Indulgence is granted, under the usual conditions, for any of the faithful who make a pilgrimage to the Basilica of Our Lady Immaculate on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception.
