Sin is often not a popular topic in our day, but it provides the background to today's readings. Both the Jewish and the Christians traditions take sin's reality and power very seriously. Both recognize that, since the time of our first parents, all human beings are subject to realities that lead them to death rather than life.

The law of Moses was offered by God as a remedy-to give life-but it was often used instead to create heavy burdens that weighed people down like a death sentence. Still, the prophets and psalmists, like Zechariah and David, could see, rejoice in and give witness to the faithful love of God for humanity-and indeed all created things-that continued to work tirelessly to restore the communion lost at the Fall and to bring about salvation.

The definitive revelation of this loving intention of God towards humanity is found in Jesus Christ (the Son, and God-with-us). In his passion and death, he put an end to the stranglehold of sin, and, in giving his own Spirit, afforded the baptized the power to live according to that Spirit, instead of the flesh.

Anyone with the simplicity of heart to respond in discipleship is assured of finding rest (salvation), peace, mercy and true freedom in Christ. For such a wondrous gift, we offer our love and praise.

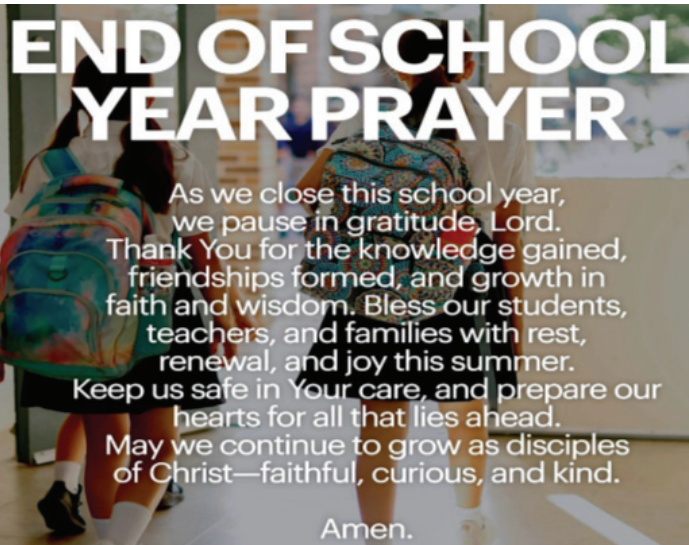
