FR. MICHAEL MCGIVNEY (1852-1890)

Michael J. McGivney, the eldest of 13 children of Irish immigrant parents, was born on August 12, 1852. Ordained in 1877, Fr. Michael J. McGivney, was assigned to St. Mary's Church, New Haven, Connecticut. In 1882, he founded the Knights of Columbus, a fraternal society of catholic men, who like their founder, sought to practice the virtues of humility and charity. Fr. McGivney, venturing into unsanitary conditions to minister to the ill and dying, eventually contracted the flu, which soon turned into pneumonia. He died peacefully on August 14, 1890, two days after his 38th birthday. In 1977, the Archdiocese of Hartford, formally opened his cause for canonization. In 2008, Pope Benedict XVI, signed a decree of heroic virtue that bestowed on Fr. McGivney the title of Venerable Servant of God. Sacred Heart Parish joined the works' of this young Irish

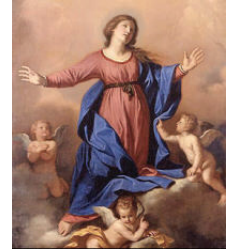
American priest, in forming the St. George Council 16183 (this number refers to the number of councils in the world, at the time of our formation, two years ago).

FEAST OF "THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY"- AUGUST 15

Today the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Assumption, a Holy Day of Obligation. On November 1, 1950, Pius XII defined the dogma of the Assumption. Thus he solemnly proclaimed that the belief whereby the Blessed Virgin Mary, at the close of her earthly life, was taken up, body and soul, into the glory of heaven, definitively forms part of the deposit of faith, received from the Apostles. To avoid all that is uncertain the Pope did not state either the manner or the circumstances of time and place in which the Assumption took place—only the fact of the Assumption of Mary, body and soul, into the glory of heaven, is the matter of the definition.
