While Abraham pleads with God to spare the innocent in the first reading, Jesus teaches his disciples in the Gospel to pray by asking. This is uncomfortable for me. Isn't it rude to ask? Wouldn't it be presumptuous? And what if I ask and God says no?

But it isn't just asking God that can be hard for me. Sometimes I expect my partner to know what I need without my asking. Not wanting to burden others or be disappointed, I avoid asking for help. Noticing this resistance, a counsellor encouraged me to face my frustration with the question, “What do I need right now?” Often it takes me a bit of time and work to even name what I need. Once I know, then it is easier to ask.

When I ask God for what I think I need, a conversation opens between us. Sometimes my need is clarified, sometimes it is met, and sometimes I feel better just by naming the need and knowing that I am waiting to see how it will be answered.

In asking God and others more often, I was surprised that the most reassuring part of asking is not what is given, but that God embraces me in my need. This is not selfish or presumptuous; asking and receiving are gifts we give to those who love us.

SUMMER TIME

A gentle reminder for the upcoming summer months: Each Catholic has the obligation to participate in the Sunday Eucharist. Vacations, cottage trips, or other activities and/or travel do



not provide valid exemption from participation. Voluntarily missing Mass is a grave sin. Canon 1247 does not only state the obligation for the faithful to participate in Mass on Sundays and other Holy Days of Obligation, but also for the faithful to abstain from works and affairs which hinder the worship to be rendered to God, the joy proper to the Lord's Day, or the suitable relaxation of mind and body. Furthermore, the Catechism of the Catholic Church (no. 2181) clearly states: "Those who deliberately fail in this obligation commit a grave sin." There may come to be, however situations which provide exemption from regular participation in the Sunday Eucharist. According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church (no. 2181) these include only serious reasons, such as illness or the care of infants. Otherwise, dispensation from participation in the Mass may be obtained from one's own pastor. Radio, television, and the Internet may facilitate participation for those prevented in taking part in the Holy Mass, especially if accompanied by the service of extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist.

POPE FRANCIS IS COMING TO CANADA



The Holy Father will visit Canada from July 24 to July 29, 2022. Pope Francis' historic visit to Canada will provide an opportunity for the Pope to listen and dialogue with Indigenous

Peoples and to address the impact of residential schools in Canada. The Holy Father will begin his Canadian visit by traveling to Edmonton, Alberta, then to Quebec City, St. Anne-de-Beaupré and then to Iqaluit, Nunavut before returning to Rome. Drawing on the theme, "Walking Together", the Holy Father's journey of reconciliation, healing and hope includes visits to a former

residential school, Indigenous pilgrimage sites, and several private and public events, including two public Masses.
