For Christians, however, these weeks should be marked by prayerful preparation for the Feast of Our Lord's Nativity. You are welcome to begin Advent this year with an Advent Service of Lessons and Carols, at the **Basilica of Our Lady Immaculate in Guelph**. This service will be a reflection on the Season of Advent through Scripture and Music, following a format that has been used for almost a century at St. John's College, Cambridge. This year's service will begin at **4:00pm** on the First Sunday of Advent, **December 1, 2024**. Please come and bring a friend!

**NOVENA FOR THE SOLEMNITY OF THE IMMACULATE
CONCEPTION**

Once again, this year a Novena (nine days) of Masses leading to the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception will be held at the **Basilica of Our Lady Immaculate in Guelph**. Novena Masses will be held at **7:30 each morning from November 30 to December 8**, and will include the Novena Prayers, and a reflection on Our Lady in the life of Christ, and the life of the Church. On the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, December 9 this year, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for Adoration at the Basilica following Morning Prayer at 8:30am, until Vespers and Benediction at 6:15pm. The Solemn Mass of the Immaculate Conception will be celebrated at 7:00pm. As the Diocese's Shrine of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Plenary Indulgence is granted, under the usual conditions, for any of the faithful who make a pilgrimage to the Basilica of Our Lady Immaculate on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception.
