LENT

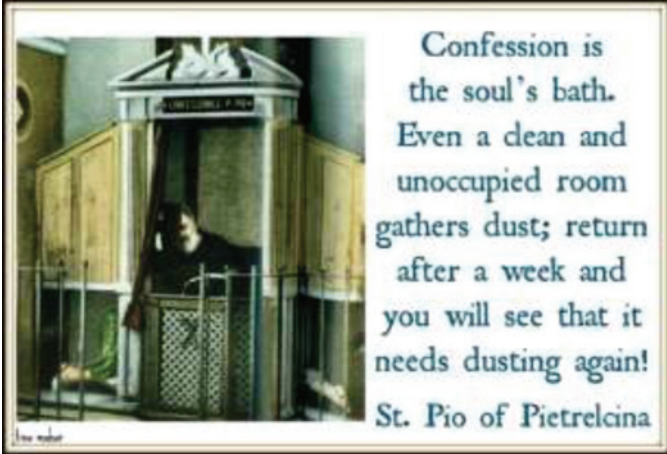


The season of Lent is a time of fasting, sacrifices, as well as prayer; its aim is to prepare our hearts for a fruitful celebration of our Lord's Resurrection. Commandments of the Church require us to restrain from participating in parties during the season of Lent, as well as to confess and receive Holy

Communion during Easter. We encourage everyone to give up something for Christ. It is still not too late. What will you give up? Smoking, alcohol, wasting time online? Perhaps you will try to be more understanding towards your spouse, or other family members. Perhaps you will give up sweets, gossiping or watching TV. Pick just one thing so that you can fully experience the season of Lent. Do this for the crucified Christ.

GOSPEL (EXCERPT), LUKE 4:1-13:

Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan, and was led by the Spirit for forty days in the wilderness, tempted by the devil. And he ate nothing in those days; and when they were ended, he was hungry. The devil said to him, "If you are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread." And Jesus answered him, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone.'" And the devil took him up, and showed him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time, and said to him, "To you I will give all this authority and their glory; for it has been delivered to me, and I give it to whom I will. If you, then, will worship me, it shall all be yours." And Jesus answered him, "It is written, 'You shall worship the Lord your God, and him only shall you serve.'"



SACRAMENT OF PENANCE

So that this Lenten period may be a time of conversion and repentance, let us try to prepare ourselves for the Sacrament of Penance by analyzing our approach. Here is a reminder of the five conditions for a good confession.

EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE

-examine the state of my soul from my last confession

SORROW FOR HAVING OFFENDED GOD

-sorry for the sins I committed

A RESOLUTION OF SIN NO MORE

-decide to do everything in my power to prevent these same sins from happening

CONFESSION OF OUR SINS

-confess ALL my sins to the priest

REPARATION TO GOD & NEIGHBOUR

-do the penance given by the priest

DAY OF PRAYER FOR VICTIMS OF SEXUAL ABUSE

MEMORANDUM

The Government of Ontario has announced that effective March 1, 2022, the following changes to the Covid-19 protocols will take place, provided that health and health care indicators continue to improve.

Effective March 1, 2022:

1. In accordance with the public health and workplace safety measures, churches may open to full capacity (the same is true for Parish halls and other meeting rooms);
2. Attendees should self- screen for any symptoms prior to arrival at Mass;
3. Masks must be worn by all those attending Mass, two years and older;
4. Hand sanitizers should continue to be available to parishioners at church entrances;
5. The use of holy water is permitted;
6. Ushers may be useful in helping parishioners with seating and traffic flow;
7. All liturgical ministers (Deacons, Extraordinary Ministers of the Communion, Lectors, Servers, Music ministers) may resume – with attention to distancing wherever possible-vaccination is not required;
8. Hymnals may be in place in the pews;
9. Congregational singing is permitted;
10. The sign of peace by shaking hands is discouraged at this time;
11. Communion in the hand is highly encouraged at this time. Those who wish to receive on the tongue should receive at the end of the Communion procession.
