**ONE HEART ONE SOUL CAMPAIGN – update as of January 30, 2022**

Our Organizing Committee is preparing for the second phase of the campaign, "February Follow Up". In this month, we will be calling the parishioners who have not yet decided if they are going to participate, and those who have said "YES", but who may have forgotten to! Our Parish Goal of \$240,000.00 is definitely in reach, with only \$12,000.00 more needed to be raised. Of course we don't have to stop at the \$240,000.00 we can raise as much as we can! Since the campaign started, the three main items needed in the church are, the "HARPOLHATER" (Mobility Lift), and new roof for the church, and a new church basement floor. For Harpolater, we have to meet with our new architect and the Building Com., to prepare the plans, and send to tender. For the new Roof, we have two companies that are in the process of giving us quotes. The Church floor will be later on. Of course, we can only spend 75% the money we have raised, approx. \$110,000.00, and the second condition is that the project is ready to start. **FROM FEAST TO FAST**



Though the shortest month of the year, February is rich in Liturgical activity. It contains a feast (Presentation of our Lord) that bridges two other seasons (Christmas and Easter)! In addition, the faithful may receive in February two of the four major public sacramentals that the Church confers during the liturgical year: blessed candles and the blessing of throats.

The Solemnity of the Presentation of the Lord on February 2nd harkens back to the Christmas mystery of Light except that now, Christ, the helpless babe, is "the Light of Revelation to the Gentiles who will save his people from their sins." Candles, symbolizing Christ our Light, will be carried in procession this day, as will be the Paschal candle during the Easter Vigil Liturgy.

"The Light of Revelation" shines more brightly with each successive Sunday of Ordinary Time, until its magnificence—exposing our sinfulness and need for conversion—propels us into the penitential Season of Lent. We prepare to accept the cross of blessed ashes on Ash Wednesday (March 2) and plunge ourselves into anticipating the major exercises of Lent—fasting, prayer, almsgiving—laying our thoughts and prayers on the heart of our Mother Mary. She, who offered her Son in the temple and on the Cross, will teach us how to deny ourselves, take up our cross daily, and follow after her Son.

**PRESENTATION OF THE LORD**

The feast was first observed in the Eastern Church as "The Encounter." In the sixth century, it began to be observed in the West: in Rome with a more penitential character and in Gaul (France) with solemn blessings and processions of candles, popularly known as "Candlemas." The Presentation of the Lord concludes the celebration of the Nativity and with the offerings of the Virgin Mother and the prophecy of Simeon, the events now point toward Easter.



"In obedience to the Old Law, the Lord Jesus, the first-born, was presented in the Temple by his Blessed Mother and his foster father. This is another 'epiphany' celebration insofar as the Christ Child is revealed as the Messiah through the canticle and words of Simeon and the testimony of Anna the prophetess. Christ is the light of the nations, hence the blessing and procession of candles on this day. In the Middle Ages this feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, or 'Candlemas,' was of great importance.

"The specific liturgy of this Candlemas feast, the blessing of candles, is not as widely celebrated as it should be, except of course whenever February 2 falls on a Sunday and thus takes precedence. There are two ways of celebrating the ceremony, either the Procession, which begins at a 'gathering place' outside the church, or the Solemn Entrance, celebrated within the church."
