

## STRATEGIES FOR SUPPORTING GRIEVING CHILDREN WORKSHOP NOV. 18

The workshop will be held at the Chancery Office, 700 King St. West in Hamilton, from 1 - 4 PM on Monday, November 18th. There will be no charge for the workshop as a result of the combined support of the Hamilton Diocese and Arbor Memorial.

Our speaker for the day will be Andrea Warnick, MA, RN, RP, Education Director, Co-Owner & CEO AWC Grief Support. Andrea is a Registered Psychotherapist and Registered Nurse whose passion lies in helping individuals, families and communities support people of all ages who are grieving an illness or death in their lives. She brings to her work a rare mixture of medical and psychosocial expertise. Andrea developed and teaches the 5 Day Certificate Program in Children's Grief and Bereavement at SickKids Centre for Community Mental Health. She was also the lead content developer for KidsGrief.ca and KidsGrief for Educators.

The death of a significant person represents one of the most powerful disruptions in all aspects of a child or youth's emotional existence. Unfortunately, it's all too common in our society for children to be on the receiving end of well-intended yet misguided advice. And yet at its core, grief is a natural and healthy process, and children possess many innate tools to help them process and integrate grief into their life. In this workshop Andrea will share practical and creative grief support strategies that can be used by anyone who finds themselves in the position of supporting a grieving child or youth, whether personally or professionally. #### SAINTS

Saints are the heroes of the Catholic faith. They lived lives in holiness, dedicated to serving God and spreading his message of salvation. Indeed, many Catholic saints courageously met their deaths simply because of their faith. Today, the saints serve as examples for all Catholics, showing us how to lead a more satisfying, more spiritual life in communion with our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. They are reminders that this life will come to an end, and only what was done for Christ will have a lasting reward. Each saint's story is a fascinating one. They lived at different times in different places throughout history, but they all shared a love of God that has been meticulously documented through the teachings of the Catholic Church.

## PURGATORY



All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified are indeed assured of their eternal salvation: but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven. The Church gives the name Purgatory to this purification of the elect, which is entirely different from the punishment of the damned. The Church formulated her doctrine of faith on Purgatory especially at the Councils of

Florence and Trent. The tradition of the Church, by reference to certain texts of Scripture, speaks of a cleansing fire. As for certain lesser faults, we must believe that, before the Final Judgment, there is a purifying fire. He Who is the truth says that whoever utters blasphemy against the Holy Spirit will be pardoned neither in this age nor in the age to come. From this sentence we understand that certain offenses can be forgiven in this age, but certain offenses in the age to come. This teaching is also based on the practice of prayer for the dead, already mentioned in Sacred Scripture: "Therefore Judas Maccabeus made atonement for the dead, that they might be delivered from their sin." From the beginning the Church has honoured the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic sacrifice, so that thus purified, they may obtain the beatific vision of God. The Church also commends almsgiving, indulgences and works of penance undertaken on behalf of the dead. Catechism of the Catholic Church
