At the beginning of this month, the World Health Organization declared that the Covid-19 virus no longer constitutes a public health emergency of international concern. All Covid-related restrictions

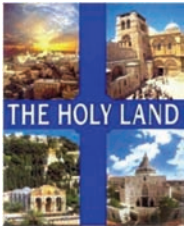

Those who are impeded from participating in Sunday Mass because of ill-health, care for the sick, or some other grave reason, are not bound by the obligation to participate in the Sunday Eucharist. CORPUS CHRISTI



Who can conceive or explain the excellence of the all-Divine gift which Jesus Christ bestows

upon us in giving us his blessed Body and Blood in the Holy Eucharist, in which we receive God with all his perfections, the plenitude of his Divinity, all the virtues and graces of his Humanity, and all the merits of the Man-God? Imitations of Christ There is nothing that Jesus desires more than that we receive Him in Holy Communion very often, every day, if possible. When He gave us the Eucharist the night before He died, He pleaded, "Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you abide in Me. I am the Vine, you are the branches" (Jn. 15:4) By abiding in Christ through frequent Holy Communion, you secure a guarantee that your prayers will be heard, for He also said, "If you abide in Me, and if my words abide in you, ask whatever you will and it shall be done to you" (Jn. 15:7). Therefore, no prayer can be more effective than that said after Holy Communion when Jesus is present in your heart as God and Man, as your best Friend, ready to listen to you and to help you with the many graces He wishes to grant you. The holier you are, the more worthy you are of getting what you ask for. Jesus comes to you in Holy Communion to make you holy and pleasing to God. "He who abides in Me, and I in him, he bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing" (Jn. 15:5). **Fr. Lovasik**
