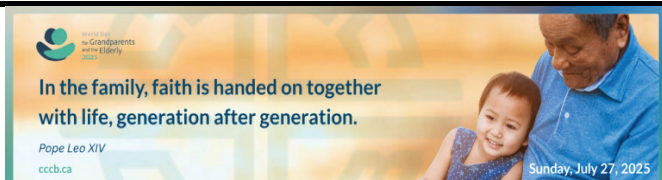
For mutual coexistence:

This year's theme is **"Blessed are those who have not lost hope"** (cf. Sir 14:2).

Pope Leo XIV, in a written message on the occasion, reminds us that the Bible abounds with examples of men and women "whom the Lord called late in life to play a part in his saving plan."
