

#### WORLD DAY OF PEACE-JANUARY 1st

The World Day of Peace was established by Pope Paul VI in 1968 who asked that "every year, this commemoration be repeated as a hope and as a promise, at the beginning of the calendar which measures and outlines the path of human life in time, that Peace with its just and beneficent equilibrium may dominate development of events to come". Each year has a specific theme, chosen by the Holy Father. January 1, 2026, the theme is "PEACE BE WITH YOU ALL".

"The greeting of the risen Christ, 'Peace be with you' (cf. Jn 20:19), is an invitation to all — believers, nonbelievers, political leaders, and citizens — to build the kingdom of God and to construct together a humane and peaceful future," the statement concludes.
