FIRE SAFETY DRILL

On Saturday, September 20th, 2025, we will be conducting a fire drill in our church **at the 7pm Mass**. We will be doing it once a year, usually around September time. Next year it will be during the 10am Mass, and the following year the 12noon Mass and so on. This is what we have posted on our entrance/exit doors in case of fire.

FIRE SAFETY PLAN* OCCUPANTS PROCEDURES FOR THE CHURCH* UPON DISCOVERY OF SMOKE OR FIRE OR NOTIFIED OF A FIRE SITUATION: Notify all occupants in the immediate area of the fire condition. Leave the building immediately by the nearest and safest exit, closing doors behind you. Call the fire department from a safe location by dialing 911, giving your name and say there is a fire at: **SACRED HEART CHURCH, 98 ALICE STREET, GUELPH.**

IF YOR ARE NOTIFIED ABOUT A SMOKE OR FIRE SITUATION OR YOU HEAR THE SMOKE ALARM ACTIVATING: Leave the building immediately by the nearest and safest exit, closing doors behind you. Call the fire department from a safe location by dialing 911, giving your name and say there is a fire at: **SACRED HEART CHURCH, 98 ALICE STREET, GUELPH.**
EVACUATION MEETING PLACE: Once you have evacuated the building proceed to an open area away from the Church to allow room for emergency vehicles and operations.

In our church we have **5 different exits** that we will be using in case of emergency. There are 3 exits at the front of the church (Gym side, Alice Street and Huron Street). To exit through those 3 exits the Ushers will release the locks on these three doors to enable full access to evacuate. Once outside you are asked to meet in front of the school gymnasium doors.

There are 2 exits at the rear of the church. The Priest's Sacristy and the Altar Server Vestry which both exit to the Huron Street. The Altar

Server Vestry exit leads to Huron Street with the panic bar gate which opens by pushing the panic bar. Once outside the gate you are asked to meet in front of the school entrance doors.

ST. PIO OF PIETRELCINA - FEAST DAY- SEPT. 23



Memorial of St. Pius of Pietrelcina (1887-1968), more popularly known as Padre Pio was born in 1887 in the small Italian village of Pietrelcina. He joined the Capuchin Friars at the age of sixteen and was ordained a priest seven years later. For fifty years at the monastery of San Giovanni Rotondo he was a much sought after spiritual advisor, confessor, and intercessor whose life was devoted to the Eucharist and prayer. Yet despite such notoriety, he would often say, "I only want to be a poor friar who prays."

On Sunday, September 21/25 at the 10am Mass, we will be celebrating the Feast Day of St. Pio of Pietrelcina with prayers
